THE DRIP AND HANDS ON ROCK

Nestled in the Goulburn River
National Park, just 50 minutes
from Wandarra Homestead, lies a
true natural wonder - The Drip.
As you stroll along the scenic
gorge trail, you'll be captivated
by the impressive sandstone
walls lining one side and the
picturesque river flowing beside
you. It's an experience that's
hard to put into words, one that
simply must be witnessed
firsthand.

Pack a delicious picnic lunch and, during the warmer months, bring your swimsuit and towel to cool off in the refreshing waters.

Before leaving, be sure to also visit the nearby Hands on Rock, where you can see ancient rock art and hand stencils left behind by the Wiradjuri people, adding a fascinating cultural element to your outdoor adventure.



GUNGUDDY (DUNNS SWAMP)

Less than 50 minutes from
Wandarra, the stunning
Ganguddy-Dunns Swamp
National Park offers a wealth of
activities for the whole family.

Explore a variety of walking trails, from easy to moderate, try your hand at fishing, or embark on a guided kayak tour with the team from **Southern Cross Kayaking**, who are on-site most weekends between the September and Easter school holidays.


